 CHILD OBSERVATION	COMMITTED TO QUALITY: The program does not require child observation.
 HEALTH & DEVELOPMENT SCREENING	HIGHEST QUALITY: The program uses a form recommended by pediatricians to check children's physical, social and emotional development, in addition to annual hearing and vision tests.
 TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION	RAISING QUALITY: Teachers have 12 to 24 college units in early childhood education and development.
 EFFECTIVE TEACHER-CHILD INTERACTIONS	EXCEEDING QUALITY: The program scores high on providing: Emotional support; An organized classroom; Consistent schedules and routines; Interactions that build vocabulary, critical thinking skills and curiosity; Lessons that include children's experiences and ideas.
 TEACHER-CHILD RATIO	HIGHEST QUALITY: The program has 3 teachers for every 9 infants; 3 teachers for every 12 toddlers; 1 teacher for every 8 preschoolers and a group size less than 20.
 ENVIRONMENT	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The program has been assessed on providing a safe, clean, and enriching environment and has a plan for improvements.
 DIRECTOR TRAINING & EDUCATION	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The Program Director has an associate degree with 24 college units in early childhood education and development, 6 units of preschool management/administration, 2 units of supervision, and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
