 CHILD OBSERVATION	COMMITTED TO QUALITY: The program does not require child observation.
 HEALTH & DEVELOPMENT SCREENING	COMMITTED TO QUALITY: The program meets licensing requirements by assessing the state of a child's health and development to determine whether the program can meet the individual needs of the child.
 TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION	COMMITTED TO QUALITY: Teachers have 12 college units in early childhood education and development or 15 hours of training on preventive health practices.
 EFFECTIVE TEACHER-CHILD INTERACTIONS	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The program has been rated on the quality of teacher-child interactions and has a plan for improvements.
 TEACHER-CHILD RATIO	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The program has 3 teachers for every 12 infants; 2 teachers for every 12 toddlers; 2 teachers for every 24 preschoolers.
 ENVIRONMENT	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The program has been assessed on providing a safe, clean, and enriching environment and has a plan for improvements.
 DIRECTOR TRAINING & EDUCATION	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The Program Director has an associate degree with 24 college units in early childhood education and development, 6 units of preschool management/administration, 2 units of supervision, and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
