 CHILD OBSERVATION	EXCEEDING QUALITY: The program evaluates children's learning and development, holds parent conferences, and uses a state-approved tool to help children learn.
 HEALTH & DEVELOPMENT SCREENING	HIGHEST QUALITY: The program uses a form recommended by pediatricians to check children's physical, social and emotional development, in addition to annual hearing and vision tests.
 TEACHER TRAINING & EDUCATION	HIGHEST QUALITY: Teachers have a Bachelor's Degree in early childhood education and development and teachers complete 21 hours of professional development annually.
 EFFECTIVE TEACHER-CHILD INTERACTIONS	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The program has been rated on the quality of teacher-child interactions and has a plan for improvements.
 TEACHER-CHILD RATIO	HIGHEST QUALITY: The program has 3 teachers for every 9 infants; 3 teachers for every 12 toddlers; 1 teacher for every 8 preschoolers and a group size less than 20.
 ENVIRONMENT	ACHIEVING QUALITY: The program has been assessed on providing a safe, clean, and enriching environment and has a plan for improvements.
 DIRECTOR TRAINING & EDUCATION	HIGHEST QUALITY: The Program Director has a Master's Degree with 30 college units in early childhood education and development, 8 units of management/administration, 2 units of supervision, and completes 21 hours of professional development annually.
